Calling all women! Wednesdays at 7:30 pm, we will begin studying the book *Just a Sister Away: A Womanist Vision of Women's Relationships in the Bible* by Renita Weems.

About the book:

Writing with African American women in mind, Renita Weems probes beneath the surface to find out how the women of the Scripture felt about themselves – by looking at how they treated other women. We will be looking at relationships between women such as Hagar and Sarah, Naomi and Ruth, and Jephthah's Daughter and the mourning women, to name a few. Believing that a common thread of sacred female experience continues to bind centuries of women, Weems offers the hope that "we are just a sister away from our healing."

This is an older book, so it's easiest to either purchase an e-reader edition like Kindle or look at used book sites like thriftbooks.com.
