Keeping a Holy Lent

For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not first sit down and estimate the cost, to see whether he has enough to complete it.

- Luke 14:28.

Keeping a holy Lent requires preparation. I've found that I must look at my calendar and write in the places I want to grow during Lent. If I don't weave it into the busy-ness of my life, it simply won't happen. I am much more likely to make it happen and enjoy leaning into God, if I schedule it.

Now there are some traditional ways to keep Lent. Prayer, abstaining from food or other comforts and giving away money are probably the most common. They probe our vulnerability and our strength in Christ. They can all make more space in our life for trusting God and loving neighbor.

Some simple things to schedule are weekly worship, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. You might also plan one special thing each week: a long walk or hike one week, a trip to a busy place to be in prayer, planting flowers, preparing eggs for children, or fasting one Friday.

My focus this Lent is the Love of Neighbor. I have some plans to help some folks that are connected to my life. I want to sit in an unhurried manner with folks who have lived longer than I have lived. I want to sit with folks who need what I have to give. I am also allowing God to show me some new ways to love my neighbor.

I hope you will tell me how you are allowing God to shape you this Lent.
